MALAYSIAN STORMWATER ORGANIZATION (MSO)







EnviroCert International, Inc.® (ECI) is a US-based, Non Profit Organization whose purpose is to safeguard life, health, and property, and to promote public welfare. EnviroCert was established to provide certification program for the practice of Stormwater Quality (CPSWQ), Erosion and Sediment Control (CPESC), Certified Professional in Municipal Stormwater Management™ (CPMSM) and Stormwater Inspections (CESSWI).









Certified Inspector Sediment and Erosion Control (CISEC)

A US-based, non-profit organisation, which administers an international certification program that recognizes the abilities, skills experience, and knowledge of **inspectors** who demonstrate their proficiency in observing, inspecting and reporting on the implementation of Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPPs) & EMP



MALAYSIAN STORMWATER ORGANIZATION (MSO)

MSO is a Malaysian registered non-profit NGO founded for the purpose of spreading know-how and awareness in Urban Stormwater Management or its more popular acronym MSMA and Erosion and Sediment Control (ESC) in Malaysia.



It manages the certifications of Certified Professionals by **EnviroCert Int (ECI)** and **CISEC** in stormwater management and ESC. Both parent organizations ECI and CISEC are based in the USA, and both offer international certifications (i.e. for any interested nationality).











MALAYSIAN STORMWATER ORGANIZATION (MSO)


MSO manages all Malaysian registrants of both organizations, on their behalf e.g. collects yearly fees, disseminates news materials, liaise with Government Departments on regulations, enforces code of ethics and is recognised to conduct their exams in Malaysia.

BRIEF HISTORY OF MSO

How it started

- 2000: Manual Saliran Mesra Alam (MSMA) was introduced
- Chapters on Best Management Practices & Erosion and Sediment Control were introduced
- 2001-2004: JPS conducted courses in ESCP with low success rate





BRIEF HISTORY OF MSO

- 2004: JPS presented a paper in MNKT. ESC Plans (ESCP) were made mandatory for all earthworks in LA areas. PE needed to sign ESCP
- 2006: Malaysian Delegation met up with the board of CPESC Inc, at their meeting in Denver, Colorado. Meeting was arranged by a Malaysian engineer, Ir. Leong Kwok Wing, who had worked in the US for 20 years previously.
- 2006: Interim Committee set up called CPESC (Malaysia)



BRIEF HISTORY OF MSO



 2007: First CPESC exam was held in Penang (14 out of 24 passed)

 2008: Large number of passes for CPESC exams DOE started conducting classes for DOE staff



2008: CESSWI AND CPSWQ was also registered in Malaysia





BRIEF HISTORY OF MSO

- 2010: Finally Malaysian Stormwater Organization (MSO) was registered as a non-profit body with the ROS
- 2011: DOE made it compulsory for Registered EIA
 Consultants with CPESC, or equivalent, can address
 Erosion and Sedimentation issues in EIA Reports and only
 PE with CPESC or equivalent prepares ESCP for EIA
 projects approved
 - DOE also require only CESSWI or equivalent, registrants to be Environmental Auditors to conduct audit for EIA projects at the construction stage
- 2012: Signing of 1st ECI/MSO Agreement
- 2013: Signing of 2nd ECI/MSO Agreement in Reno, USA





Objectives of MSO (cont)


To act as the coordinating centre for individual, organization, institution and other similar bodies to share common interests in the fields of stormwater management.
